






### 1. Satellite

Connect the cable from Satellite

#### 2. AV Receiver Connection

Use an AV receiver for better audio quality. Connect the receiver's SPDIF connector to the AV receiver's digital audio input connector using an optical audio cable.

#### 3. HDMI Connection

Connect the receiver's HDMI output connectors to the TV's HDMI input connector using an HDMI cable.

#### 4. Network Connection

Connect the receiver LAN port to the router using a network cable. For details, please refer to the Network Settings on.

#### 5. Power Up

A power cord with an adapter is provided in an accessory.

Plug the round end of the adapter power cord into the power input.

# Remote Controller (RCU)



### **Programmable Remote part**

How to program for TV RCU button (Example: Power button):

- Press "SET" key for 3 seconds, the red light on.
- Press "POWER" key in TV CONTROL area in 10 seconds, the red light flash.
- Keep TV remote IR and STB remote IR face to face in 3cm, press "POWER" key on TV remote, the red light flash 3 times and keep lighting, learning successful.
- Repeat step 2 and 3 to learn other keys.
   Press "SET" key again to exit learning status.

### STB part

- 1. POWER: To control STB power.
- 2. Digit 0 ~ 9 and . : to put channel number / IP address etc.
- 3. Back Space : To delete word.
- 4. Next/Previous file: Move to next or previous file.
- 5. Resolution: Change resolution of 720p,1080i,1080p,2160p.
- 6. Mute: Sound Mute.
- 7. Rewind: Rewind Media.
- 8. Play/Pause: Pause/Play Media.
- 9. Stop: Stop to play/record Media.
- 10. Fast Forward: To move Fast forward.
- 11. TV Guide: Electrical program Guide.
- 12. INFO(i): Information for TV channel.
- 13. Exit: Exit or Back.
- 14. Menu: to load Menu in Apps.
- 15. Home: Go Android Home.
- 16. Vol +, -: To increase/decrease volume.
- 17. CH +, -: To change channel.
- 18. Color buttons: to use specific function in App. E.g. in Live TV app yellow button- Subtitle/Teletext, green button-Sound, red button-Popup Menu.
- 19. Apps: To call Android App list.
- 20. Mouse: Change Mouse mode.
- 21, Resolution: Change Ratio of 4:3, 16:9,





After purchasing the product, connect the TV and AB IPBOX box with the HDMI cable, connect the DC power adapter to turn on the power.



Start screen of Settings-Network.




If "Settings" option is selected, the following screen is displayed.

If you do not use WIFI, you do not need to read this section. When you specify the WIFI Network to use, the Setting page with the password is displayed. Please enter your password.



Online reinstallation: ATTENTION - selecting this item will delete all applications for you. This is a reinstallation of the full system.


Update options:

Full version: Clears all data, including applications.




When the download is completed as shown below, the AB IPBOX box will reboot automatically and the upgrade will start with the downloaded image.




### Press OK button.

When the process is completed, the AB IPBOX box will proceed with the reboot.




You have just upgraded your system. Set up your local / personal user interface before using the product. After completing the basic update, continue with the following basic configuration.

When using the Home Launcher, the main application and user application are listed in the middle of the screen.

There are applications to go to the app that you frequently use with the remote control. If you want to change the order of this app, place the cursor on the desired application, press "OK" key for 3 to 5 seconds.

Please select an application icon that you want to move, place the icon to desired location. Press the "OK" button.



You are now roughly finished with the default settings. It is time to install the default app you need.

The Android for TV differs from the Google Play in general Android Google Play.

So, the fact that some regular mobile Android app does not work in AB IPBOX box is normal. To complement that you can not find mobile Apps in AB IPBOX box. So we also provide "Market" to find other Apps. This is a backup App to replace the Google Mobile App Store.

# Live TV

User Preferences explains the menus provided by Live TV.



This is the main screen configuration of the application.

When running for the first time, there is no channel, so it moves to the main screen.

- 1. Live TV: Watch live TV when there is a saved (scanned) channel.
- 2. Scan: Search for channels.
- 3. Setup: Live TV system configuration and channel data backup/restore.
- 4. Exit: Exit the Live TV application.




#### 1. Search Mode:

- Preset Scan: Scan by pre-programmed TP information.
- · Blind Scan: Scan by tuner input signal.
- · Manual Scan: Scan by manual TP information.
- Fast Scan: Scan by manual TP information.
- 2. Select Satellite for scanning.
- 3. LNB Type: Select LNB that you are using.
- 4. Switch Setup: Select proper switch for antenna.
- 5. Press Red button to scan.
- After scanning channels, press "Exit" button, then channel will be stored and go to Live TV to enjoy Live TV channels.

Press "OK" on RCU, You can manage channel list.



Press "left" arrow button on RCU, You can manage Simple channel list.




Press "right" or " ← " button on RCU, You can manage Recall list.

When you change channel, you can see channel information.

If you want to see more information with detail EPG, press "info" button twice.





Then you can use Arrow key to choose some function like Sub-menu, Timer, Record, Record list, Lock, Subtitle, Teletext, Audio sound.

- 1. Timer list: Add / Remove timer for recording or reminder.
- 2. Recording: Start recording.
- 3. File list: Play recordings.
- 4. Channel lock.
- 5. Subtitle / Teletext: To use the subtitle / teletext function.
- 6. Left / Right sound: For left / right control.






### **PVR**

Select option like duration, storage device. Then press "Start" button then will start recording.

After setting Time shift function,

To use time shift function, in Live TV mode, press " u button then you can enter time shift mode.



In time shift mode, you can use **(4) (1) (b) (1)** button to control for Timeshift feature.

# **Program Guide**



#### It allows:

- 1. RED button.: Switches between single and multi EPG display.
- 2. Green Button: Displays the EPG from the previous day.
- 3. Yellow button: Displays the EPG from the next day.
- 4. Blue Button: Reserves an EPG event to watch.
- 5. Button Recordings: Adds a timer for the EPG event.
- 6. ⟨ : Displays a list of timers.


#### Add timer

- In the EPG, use the button ☒ (located in the lower left corner on the remote control) to call up the list of timers, press the green button "Add timer.
- You can select "View" or "Upload".
- Set the channel / time / duration / storage to record a channel or box switch to a channel.





**Edit Group List:** Enable/ Disable Favorite/ Provider/ FTA/Scramble/ HD/ UHD.



In the left window, select the desired FAV group using the ▼ / ▲ buttons.

Use the → button to move to all channels and use the green button to add the desired programs to the selected FAV group. Repeat the procedure to create another FAV group.






Delete Channels: Select channel to delete in list permanently.





- 4. External EPG (xmltv.xml): Loads an xml-based external EPG.


- 5. Information on the LCD display.
- Audio Out Weight: Adjusts the TV volume level.(You can specify from 30 to 100)
- 7. L/R Arrow key setting: Set the operation method of left and right arrow keys. (Sound control: Volume up & down / Show channel list: Simple channel list and history list)




- User Interface: Set up the user interface.
- Infobar Timeout: Set the time the infobar disappears when switching channels. (You can specify from 1 to 10 seconds)
- 2. Info box Transparency: Set the transparency of the info box.  $(0\% \sim 50\% \text{ can be specified})$
- 3. ChanneList Background Color: Set the channel list background color.
- 4. Setup Background Color: Set the background color of the configuration page.
- 5. Main Background: Select the main menu background image.
- 6. Menu Skin: Select the main menu skin type.
- 7. EPG Action: Set the action method when the OK button is pressed in the EPG window. (Watch channel: Watch channel/ Set Time : Add timer)




- **Backup:** You can back up channel and user data and restore it when the device is initialized.
- 1. Backup channel data to storage: Backup channel data to USB storage.
- Resore channel data from storage : Recovers channel data from USB storage.
- 3. Backup user data to storage: Backup user data to USB storage.
- 4. Resore user data from storage: Recover user data from USB storage.



- Access Control: Initializes system access control.
- 1. Set Pin Code: Set the pin code. (Initial pin code is 0000.)
- 2. Scan Menu: Set the permission to access the Start menu. (Unlock / Lock)
- 3. Rest: Set the access authority of the Rest menu. (Unlock / Lock)
- 4. Backup: Set the access authority of the backup menu. (Unlock / Lock)



- Reset: Channel-related data and factory reset.
- 1. Reset Channels Data: Deletes all searched channel data.
- 2. Initialize User Favorites: Initializes the user favorites list.
- 3. Reset Channels EPG Data: Initializes EPG data.
- 4. Clear Timers: Initializes the timer data.
- 5. Reload group: Restores the channel group.
- 6. Factory Reset: Performs factory reset.


